

[RSS Feed](#) curation is often confused with [Content Curation](#), because when done properly, curated feeds can be combined to create feed aggregation websites that are extremely useful to the end user (while also supporting your SEO objectives). One such example of an RSS curated website is Apple Investor News which is as RSS Curated by a professional journalist. Individual articles are not curated, but entire feed and feed sources are carefully curated. This website still creates revenue based on the monetization model.

Unlike [content curation services](#), RSS curated websites do not curate one article at a time. In fact, RSS sites can be fully automated, with entire RSS Feeds being curated rather than individual articles.
